ORDINANCE NO. 23-1166

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WHEREAS, that certain document known as "2023 Amendments to the Douglas Zoning Code and Chapter 2.32" was adopted as a public record by Resolution No. 23-1544 on April 12, 2023;

WHEREAS, the City Council previously adopted Ordinances which established laws and regulations related to zoning within the City of Douglas;

WHEREAS, on March 21, 2023 the Planning and Zoning Commission recommended approval of ZCA-2023-01 and ZCA-2023-03 subject to certain conditions of approval;

WHEREAS, the City of Douglas Mayor and Council believe, after consultation with its staff, that amending the Zoning Code to update the rules and regulations related to zoning within the City of Douglas would be in the best interest of the City of Douglas; and

WHEREAS, A.R.S. §9-802 and the City Charter allows the City to adopt a public record by Ordinance as a means to reduce publication costs while ensuring that the public gets fair notice and opportunity to review its operative provisions.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Douglas, Arizona, as follows:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to Arizona Revised Statutes Section 9-802 and the City Charter, that certain document known as "2023 Amendments to the Douglas Zoning Code and Chapter 2.32" of the Douglas City Code, electronic copies of which are on file in the office of the City Clerk, which document was made a public record by Resolution No. 23-1544, is hereby referred to, adopted and made a part hereof in this Ordinance.

SECTION 2. Articles 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 10, 11, 12, 13, and 14 of Title 17, the Douglas Zoning Code, and Chapter 2.32 of the Douglas Municipal Code are hereby amended as outlined in "2023 Amendments to the Douglas Zoning Code and Chapter 2.32" which was made public record by Resolution No. 23-1544 of the City of Douglas, Arizona.
