SUBJECT: RESOLUTION NO. 23-1547, a Resolution of the Mayor and Council of the City

of Douglas, Cochise County, Arizona, APPROVING the COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) ANNUAL ACTION PLAN fiscal year

2023 for the City of Douglas.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The City of Douglas is a CDBG entitlement community. The CDBG grant requires that a Consolidated Plan for every 5-year cycle, as well as an Annual Action Plan for every year of that cycle be prepared and submitted to HUD for approval. The plan (along with all required documents) must be received by HUD at least 45 days before the start of the fiscal year (on or before May 16, 2023); CDBG funds allocated for FY2023 are \$165,619.

BACKGROUND:

Staff requests Mayor and Council's approval of and authorization to submit the Annual Action Plan FY2023 to HUD for CDBG funds. The funding allocation for FY2023 is \$165,619.

DISCUSSION:

Staff recommends that these funds be used towards infrastructure improvements – installation and/or replacement of sewer line along North Rogers Avenue from East Applewhite Drive to 20th Street.

\$132,495

The remainder of the funding will be used to cover administrative expenses associated with the administration of the CDBG grant. (\$33,124).
