**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF DOUGLAS, COCHISE COUNTY, ARIZONA,
AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF GRANT FUNDING
IN THE AMOUNT OF \$10,000 FROM THE SONORAN
INSTITUTE FOR A MUNICIPAL CODE REVIEW AND
CODIFICATION OF WATER CONSERVATION GOALS
OUTLINED IN THE GENERAL PLAN.**

WHEREAS, the City of Douglas is committed to sustainable water management and the implementation of water conservation strategies as outlined in the General Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Sonoran Institute has awarded the City of Douglas a grant in the amount of \$10,000 to support a municipal code review and the codification of water conservation goals; and

WHEREAS, the City of Douglas recognizes the importance of updating its municipal code to reflect best practices in water conservation and sustainable development.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Douglas, Arizona, as follows:

1. The City of Douglas accepts the grant award of \$10,000 from the Sonoran Institute for the purpose of conducting a municipal code review and codifying water conservation goals.
2. The City Manager and the City Clerk are hereby authorized to execute any forthcoming grant agreement and any necessary documents required for the implementation and administration of the grant.
3. The City Manager and city staff are directed to take all necessary actions to ensure compliance with the grant terms and to implement the funded activities in alignment with the City's General Plan objectives.
4. This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon passage and adoption.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City of Douglas expresses its sincere gratitude to the Sonoran Institute for their generous grant, which will significantly contribute to responsible resource management.
