EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The City of Douglas applied to the Sonoran Institute for the AZ Growing Water Smart Technical Assistance grant program and has been awarded \$10,000 to support a municipal code review and the codification of water conservation goals in alignment with the City's General Plan. This funding will assist in updating local regulations to ensure sustainable water management practices.
