2 **A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY**
3 **OF DOUGLAS, COCHISE COUNTY, ARIZONA, AUTHORIZING**
4 **THE EXECUTION OF AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL**
5 **AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF DOUGLAS AND THE**
6 **COCHISE COUNTY COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT**
7 **REGARDING THE EXTENSION OF UTILITY SERVICES AND**
8 **BACKUP WELL.**

9 **WHEREAS**, the city is extending water to the Cochise College Douglas Campus to build a new Water
10 Campus and support the operation of a new Commercial Land Port of Entry; and

11 **WHEREAS**, the college desires to be a water customer and connect a service line from the city’s Water
12 Campus to the College Douglas Campus; and

13 **WHEREAS**, the existing Cochise College Well #1 will be, through this agreement, utilized for backup
14 water purposes to the city’s Well Campus and the city will be responsible to provide a service line from
15 the College Well #1 to the city’s Water Campus; and

16 **WHEREAS**, it is in the best interests of the City of Douglas to enter into an IGA and partner with the
17 college to establish a redundant water source at the Water Campus.

18 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Mayor and Council of the City of Douglas, Arizona,
19 as follows:

20 **Section 1.** The terms of the IGA are in the best interest of the City of Douglas.

21 **Section 2.** The Mayor and the City Clerk are hereby authorized to execute and deliver the
22 Intergovernmental Agreement and collaborate with the Cochise County Community College District and
23 any related documents necessary to consummate the transaction contemplated by this IGA.

24 **Section 3.** The officers of the City Council and the City of Douglas are hereby authorized and directed
25 to fulfill all obligations under the terms of the Intergovernmental Agreement.
