5	FULL COST REIMBURSEMENT AND CONNECTION FEES TO BE CHARGED WITH AN AGREEMENT TO ANNEX INTO THE CITY IN THE FUTURE.
7	WHEREAS, the City of Douglas has existing water and sewer infrastructure that feeds the surrounding unincorporated communities providing essential drinking and clean water services to these communities
8	with the future opportunity to annex into the city; and
9	WHEREAS, the city wants to encourage development in and around the Douglas area to encourage growth and development, thus offering water extension services to these residents at cost; and
10	WHEREAS, the attached agreement establishes policies to accept an arrangement to extend services at either the city doing the work at cost or contracting and charging the costs upfront and associated connection fees; and
13	WHEREAS, signing of the agreement also includes consent to annex into the City of Douglas in a future petition.
14	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of the City of Douglas, Arizona, as follows:
15	Section 1. Approving the City of Douglas Agreement to Extend Utility Service Outside City Limits incorporated herein by reference, is in the best interest of the City of Douglas.
17	Section 2. The City Manager and the City Clerk are hereby authorized to sign agreements for and on behalf of the City of Douglas with individual owners desiring to participate in this program.
18	Section 3. The officers of the City Council and the City of Douglas are hereby authorized and directed to fulfill all obligations under the terms of the Agreement.
