WHEREAS, The Douglas Police Department has been informed by the State of Arizona Department of Homeland Security, in cooperation with the U.S. Border Patrol will be accepting reimbursable grant funding as an allocation under the Federal Fiscal Year 2021 Operation Stonegarden Reallocation Grant Program as part of the U.S. Department of Homeland Security Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the City of Douglas Police Department will be accepting financial assistance as part of a grant program from the State of Arizona Department of Homeland Security (AZDOHS) under the Operation Stonegarden Grant Program for personnel overtime costs in the amount of \$201,958 and mileage costs in the amount of \$26,640 as part of the grant funding reallocation in the total amount of \$228,598 to include execution of a Subgrantee Agreement to be entered into by the parties.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of the City of Douglas, Arizona, as follows:

Section 1. To authorize the acceptance of reimbursable grant funding in the amount of \$228,598 and approving the terms of the Subgrantee Agreement as being in the best interest of the City of Douglas.

Section 2. The City Manager, City Clerk as well as the Police Chief are hereby authorized to accept said grant funding and are further authorized to execute and deliver any documents necessary to consummate the transaction contemplated by the Subgrantee Agreement for and on behalf of the City of Douglas.
