EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The Arizona Department of Homeland Security selected the department to receive \$217,000 in funding under the FFY 2023 Operation Stonegarden Award Allocation Grant Program. The performance period for this grant cycle is April 1, 2024 through March 31, 2025.

BACKGROUND:

The Operation Stonegarden Program was implemented to enhance security along the nation's border regions. This is achieved through a cooperative and coordinated enforcement effort between state and local law enforcement agencies and the U.S. Border Patrol, targeting specific routes of egress that could potentially be used by criminal organizations to smuggle terrorists, weapons of mass destruction, and other contraband into the United States from Mexico.

The Police Department has participated in the Operation Stonegarden Program since its inception and to date all expenditures have been reimbursed in full.
