SUBJECT: **SECOND READING OF ORDINANCE NO. 25-1217**, an Ordinance of the Mayor and Council of the City of Douglas, Cochise County, Arizona, **AMENDING CHAPTER 8.28** of the **DOUGLAS MUNICIPAL CODE** relating to NOISE, establishing severability of components of ordinance; and establishing an effective date thereof.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The Mayor and Council find it to be in the best interest of the city to amend Section 8.28 relating to noise and allow special occasions, gatherings, and general parties within the community to extend until 12:00 a.m. (midnight) on Fridays and Saturdays.

BACKGROUND:

Section 8.28.020(A) is being amended to clarify when the activities listed in Section 8.28.020 are in violation of the Noise Ordinance. Additionally, an exception to the Noise Ordinance is being added to Section 8.28.040 for special occasions and social gatherings between 10:00 p.m. and 12:00 a.m. (midnight) on Fridays and Saturdays that do not create Unreasonable Noise.
