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WHEREAS, the City of Douglas Fire Department provides emergency medical services to residents of Douglas and surrounding rural areas and strives to improve cardiac arrest care and patient outcomes; and

WHEREAS, the Legacy Foundation of Southeast Arizona has awarded the City of Douglas a grant in the amount of \$50,000 to fund the purchase of two piston-style automated chest-compression devices for use in city ambulances; and

WHEREAS, acceptance of the grant and timely implementation of Project Lifeline: Advancing CPR with Innovation will strengthen the city's life-saving capabilities and benefit residents and patients served by Douglas Fire Department.

Section 1. The City of Douglas hereby formally accepts the grant award from the Legacy Foundation of Southern Arizona in the amount of \$50,000 for Project Lifeline: Advancing CPR with Innovation.

Section 3. The city agrees to comply with all applicable federal, state, and local laws, regulations, and grant conditions.
