

RESOLUTION NO. 25-1652

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DOUGLAS, COCHISE COUNTY, ARIZONA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF DOUGLAS TO ENTER INTO A DATA ACCESS / EXCHANGE AGREEMENT WITH THE ARIZONA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE PURPOSES OF REPORTING AND QUERYING DATA IN THE ARIZONA CRASH INFORMATION SYSTEM (ACIS).

WHEREAS, the Arizona Department of Transportation (ADOT) is responsible for collecting vehicle crash report information throughout the state of Arizona; and

WHEREAS, ADOT authorizes reporting agencies to submit and query crash report information through its Crash Records Information System (CRIS) and Arizona Crash Information System (ACIS) by way of formal agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Data Access / Exchange Agreement provides the requirements and safeguards that must be followed by both parties to the agreement for the security of information provided and/or queried; and

WHEREAS, the city is legally authorized to enter into said compact with the state agency pursuant to A.R.S. §11-952 and §48-572.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Douglas, Arizona, as follows:

Section 1. The terms and conditions of the Data Access/Exchange Agreement to be entered into by the parties is attached in Exhibit "A", and incorporated herein by reference as though fully set forth herein verbatim, and are found to be in the best interest of the City of Douglas.

Section 2. The City Manager, the City Clerk as well as the Chief of Police, are hereby authorized to execute and deliver the Agreement and any related documents necessary to consummate the transaction contemplated by the agreement for and on behalf of the City of Douglas.

Section 3. The officers of the City Council and the City of Douglas are hereby authorized and directed to fulfill all obligations under the terms of the Agreement.
