15 2026, by the adoption of Propositions 468, 471, 472, 473, 474, 476, and 482; and the seven amendments to the  
16 City Charter shall be sent to the Governor for approval.

16 **Section 4.** The City Clerk is hereby directed to certify the election results, enter this Resolution into the official  
17 records of the city, and take all necessary actions to complete and file the official canvass in accordance with  
18 Arizona law.

18 **Section 5.** This Resolution shall be in full force and effective immediately upon its adoption.
