EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

Pursuant to City Charter Article IX, Section 14, the election results are being declared and canvassed within seven days after the primary election held on March 8, 2022. The official results issued by the Cochise County Elections Department are included as part of the resolution for your review and final adoption.

BACKGROUND:

Pursuant to ARS 16-226, the City of Douglas published the Call of Election on September 29, 2021, and October 6, 2021, to inform the City of Douglas citizens on the three council seats that were up for election in Wards 2, 4 and 6 for a four-year term to expire in 2026. The Call of Election was published in the Sierra Vista Herald, posted on the city's website and social media channels for public awareness.

Candidate packet distribution was October 4, 2021, and the filing deadline was November 8, 2021.
