SUBJECT: **RESOLUTION NO. 25-1693**, a Resolution of the Mayor and Council of the City of Douglas, Cochise County, Arizona, **AUTHORIZING** the City of Douglas to **ACCEPT GRANT FUNDING** and enter into an agreement with the STATE of ARIZONA GOVERNOR'S OFFICE of HIGHWAY SAFETY for reimbursable grant in the amount of **\$12,000** for **OCCUPANT PROTECTION ENFORCEMENT OVERTIME**.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The Douglas Police Department has been selected to receive grant funding from the Arizona Governor's Office of Highway Safety (GOHS) for Occupant Protection Enforcement in the amount of \$12,000.

BACKGROUND:

The Arizona Governor's Office of Highway Safety solicited proposals for consideration under the Federal 405b Plan. Sgt. David Acosta prepared a proposal for Personnel Overtime (including ERE's) for Occupant Protection Enforcement. Officers will participate in enforcement details during holidays and other planned dates. Please review the attached contract for additional details.

Previously grant funds have been received from the Governor's Office of Highway Safety for DUI and Selective Traffic Enforcement which has served to increase the number of DUI arrests and raise traffic safety awareness within the city and surrounding areas.

The grant period runs from 10/1/2025 through 9/30/2026. Total anticipated award amount is \$12,000.
