"let us solemnly remember the sacrifices of all those who fought valiantly, on the seas, in the air, and on foreign shores, to preserve our heritage and freedom and let us consecrate ourselves to the task of promoting an enduring peace so that their efforts shall not have been in vain": and

WHEREAS, the City of Douglas, Arizona, a Purple Heart City, along with the rest of the nation is forever indebted to our Veterans for their quiet courage and exemplary service, we are proud to recognize Veterans and extend our appreciation to those who have worn and wear the uniforms of the United States Armed Forces; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT I, Donald C. Huish, Mayor and on behalf of the Council, do hereby proclaim November 11, 2023 as

Veteran's Day

And urge and encourage all to recognize the bravery and sacrifice of our Veterans through ceremonies, recognition, and direct appreciation. I call upon local citizens to display the flag of the United States and to support and participate in patriotic activities in the community. I invite civic and fraternal organizations, places of worship, schools, businesses, unions, media, and all citizens to support this national observance with commemorative expressions and programs.
