**SUBJECT:** **RESOLUTION NO. 21-1474**, a Resolution of the Mayor and Council of the City of Douglas, Cochise County, Arizona, AUTHORIZING the CITY OF DOUGLAS to ACCEPT GRANT FUNDING and ENTER into a SUBGRANTEE AGREEMENT with the STATE OF ARIZONA DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY for a REIMBURSABLE GRANT FUND allocation in the amount of \$47,639.87 for EQUIPMENT under OPERATION STONEGARDEN Fiscal Year 2019 Award-Reallocation Grant Program.

**EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:**

The Arizona Department of Homeland Security selected the Department to receive \$47,639.87 in funding under the FFY 2019 Operation Stonegarden Award Reallocation Grant Program. The performance period for this grant cycle is August 5, 2021 through July 31, 2022.

**BACKGROUND:**

The Department was selected to receive the following equipment under the Arizona Department of Homeland Security grant:

- (1) X-ray scanner/Density Meter

The Operation Stonegarden Program was implemented to enhance security along the nation’s border regions. This is achieved through a cooperative and coordinated enforcement effort between state and local law enforcement agencies and the U.S. Border Patrol, targeting specific routes of egress that could potentially be used by criminal organizations to smuggle terrorists, weapons of mass destruction, and other contraband into the United States from Mexico.

The Police Department has participated in the Operation Stonegarden Program since its inception and to date all expenditures have been reimbursed in full.
