**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE  
CITY OF DOUGLAS, COCHISE COUNTY, ARIZONA,  
AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF GRANT FUNDING  
IN THE AMOUNT OF \$46,800 FROM THE TOHONO  
O'ODHAM NATION FOR THE BRYAN'S WAY PROJECT.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Douglas recognizes the critical importance of pedestrian safety and acknowledges the need for comprehensive measure to enhance the well-being of residents; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Douglas applied for and was awarded a grant from the Tohono O'odham Nation in the amount of \$46,800 to support the implementation of pedestrian safety measures in our community; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Douglas was awarded a \$46,800 to be used for the installation of high visibility crosswalks, the implementation of curbing work to ensure ADA compliance, facilitating safe and accessible pedestrian pathways, and the design, production, and installation of informative signage to guide pedestrians and motorists and promote awareness of the newly implemented safety measures.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Council of the City of Douglas, Arizona, as follows:

1. The City of Douglas accepts the Tohono O'odham grant award of \$46,800.
2. The City Manager and the City Clerk are hereby authorized to execute any forthcoming Tohono O'odham Nation 12% Gaming Distribution Fund grant for \$46,800.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the City of Douglas expresses its sincere gratitude to the Tohono O'odham Nation for their generous grant, which will significantly contribute to the enhancement of pedestrian safety within our community.
