EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The Douglas Police Department has been selected to receive grant funding from the Arizona Governor's Office of Highway Safety (GOHS) for Occupant Protection Enforcement in the amount of \$25,000.

BACKGROUND:

The Arizona Governor's Office of Highway Safety solicited proposals for consideration under the FFY2022 grant cycle. Sgt.
