PROGRAM (STEP) OVERTIME.
WHEREAS, the City of Douglas Police Department applied for a financial assistance grant from the State of Arizona Governor's Office of Highway Safety in the amount of \$8,000 to support the Department's Selective Traffic Enforcement Program (STEP) overtime; and
WHEREAS , the City of Douglas Police Department has been informed by the State of Arizona Governor's Office of Highway Safety that the grant application has been awarded and that a Grantee Agreement will need to be entered into by the parties for receipt of said grant award; and

Section 1. Section 2. The Interim City Manager, the City Clerk as well as the Police Chief are hereby authorized to accept said grant funding and are further authorized to execute and deliver any documents necessary to consummate the transaction contemplated by the Grantee Agreement for and on behalf of the City of Douglas.
