# Project Purpose


- Identify preferred sites to accommodate:
  - Transit administrative office with customer service functions
  - Secured vehicle storage
    - Sulphur Springs/Lawrence site selected for vehicle storage and remains the preferred location
  - Conduct environmental analysis work necessary to be eligible for federal assistance for construction








# Previously Evaluated Sites

### Site 7 - 9<sup>th</sup> Street & San Antonio Avenue






**1815 9th Street**

#### **Adjacent Streets and Classification**

- 9th Street Local Road
- San Antonio Avenue Minor Collector (North of 9<sup>th</sup> St.), Local Road (South of 9<sup>th</sup> St.)
- 8<sup>th</sup> Street Major Collector
- 10<sup>th</sup> Street Major Collector

#### Sidewalk Network within 1/4-mile

The sidewalk network is inconsistent in the site area. There is a sidewalk on the north side of 9<sup>th</sup> Street and adjacent to the Wells Fargo bank. Sidewalks are present along San Antonio Avenue and generally inconsistent adjacent to single family homes on 9<sup>th</sup> Street.

#### **Location Context**

Located one parcel west of the intersection of 9<sup>th</sup> Street and San Antonio Avenue. This site is adjacent to neighborhood commercial, mutifamily, and institutional uses.
