



# **United Way Care Acts CDBG-CV Douglas**



- City of Douglas entered grant agreement with U.S. Department of Housing & Urban Development (HUD) for financial assistance to conduct Community Development Block Grant Coronavirus relief (CDBG-CV).
- City of Douglas contacted United Way of Sierra Vista & Cochise County to administer the grant.

- Initial CDBG funds totaled \$95,500.
- An additional \$47,793 was added.
- Total CDBG funds was \$145,683.



- City of Douglas directed the funds be distributed as follows:
  - Rent/Utilities Assistance (\$45,300)
  - Food Assistance (\$25,400)
  - COVID Testing/Administration (\$67,818)
  - Administrative Fees (\$7,165)



- Rent/Utilities

- Partnered with St. Vincent de Paul-Douglas
- Assisted 1,248 persons, 428 families – including 573 children
- 126 persons were Single Females/Head of Household
- 19 persons were Elderly Females



- Food Assistance

- Initially partnered with DARC (Meals on Wheels) & Douglas Area Food Bank
- Fed more than 400 local families and stacked and provided much-needed food boxes for local smaller non-profits and churches

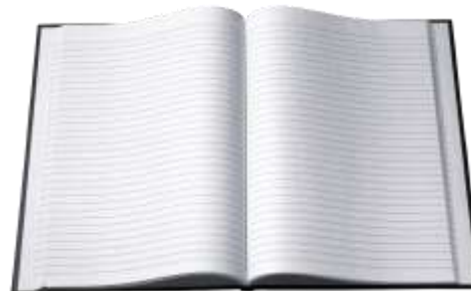


- COVID-19 Testing
  - Partnered with Chricahua Community Health Center
  - Provided 911 COVID tests for community members
  - After vaccine became available, CDBG funds covered administrative costs for COVID vaccine shots for 814 community members



- **Administrative Fees**

- United Way charged the City of Douglas 5% of total CDBG amount
- Ensured all funds were distributed per agreement
- Provided monthly accountability of all funds
- Worked diligently with City of Douglas when changes had to be made based on community needs
