**AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DOUGLAS, COCHISE COUNTY, ARIZONA, ADOPTING THE DOCUMENT FILED WITH THE CITY CLERK AND ENTITLED “2026 AMENDMENTS TO TITLE 2” BY REFERENCE TO AMEND THE DOUGLAS MUNICIPAL CODE TITLE 2 RELATING TO THE DOUGLAS AIRPORT AUTHORITY, ESTABLISHING SEVERABILITY OF COMPONENTS OF ORDINANCE; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.**

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Council find it to be in the best interest of the city to amend Title 2 of the Douglas Municipal Code to make certain changes to the Douglas Airport Authority; and

**WHEREAS**, A.R.S. §9-802 allows a city to adopt a public record by Ordinance as a means to reduce publication costs while ensuring that the public gets fair notice and opportunity to review its operative provisions.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Mayor and Council of the City of Douglas, Arizona, as follows:

**SECTION 1.** That certain document filed with the City Clerk and entitled “2026 Amendments to Title 2” amending Title 2 of the Douglas Municipal Code as set forth in Exhibit A, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, is hereby declared a public record. One copy and one electronic copy of Exhibit A shall be maintained in compliance with A.R.S. § 44-7041 and available for public inspection during normal business hours in the Office of the City Clerk and shall be available on the city’s website at: [www.douglasaz.gov](http://www.douglasaz.gov).

**SECTION 2.** Title 2 of the Douglas Municipal Code is hereby amended as set forth in Exhibit A, and that the amendments depicted therein are hereby approved and adopted.

**SECTION 3.** To the extent of any conflict between other city Ordinances and this Ordinance, this Ordinance shall be deemed to be controlling; provided, however, that this Ordinance is not intended to amend or repeal any existing city Ordinance, Resolution or regulation except as expressly set forth herein.

**SECTION 2.** Severability: If any part or clause or sentence of this Ordinance is declared by any Court of competent jurisdiction to be illegal or unconstitutional, then the remainder of this ordinance shall not be deemed affected and shall continue in full force and effect after the deletion of the illegal or unconstitutional provision.

**SECTION 3.** This Ordinance provision shall be effective thirty (30) days after final approval and adoption by the Mayor and Council.
