WHEREAS, the parties wish to amend the Agreement specifically in relation to the fee structure for services rendered under the Agreement;

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties agree to amend the Agreement as follows:

1. Section 2 of the Agreement is amended as follows:

The fee for any planning and zoning services or assistance conducted by County personnel, as stated under the original Agreement, shall be increased from seventy-five dollars (\$75.00) per hour to ninety-five dollars (\$95.00) per hour, effective immediately upon the execution of this Addendum.

All other terms related to billing and payment as stipulated in the Agreement shall remain unchanged and in full effect.

- 2. Except as amended herein, all other provisions of the original Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
- 3. This Addendum may be executed in counterparts.
