SUBJECT: **RESOLUTION NO. 22-1511**, a Resolution of the Mayor and Council of the City of Douglas, Cochise County, Arizona, **AUTHORIZING an INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT** between the **CITY of DOUGLAS** and the **DOUGLAS UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 27** for purposes of providing **PARAMEDIC/EMT** and **ANIMAL CONTROL INTERNSHIP/EXTERNSHIP** experience to High School students in the City of Douglas.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

For Mayor & Council's consideration, we are bringing forth an Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) between the Douglas School District and the City of Douglas for Douglas High School student internships.

BACKGROUND:

Since 2012, Mayor & Council have approved an Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) to allow Douglas High School students in certain career training courses to commit hours at some City of Douglas work sites as part of their course requirements. These internship opportunities will be made primarily available to students at the Douglas Police and Fire Departments.

The Douglas Unified School district will provide general liability protection and such additional forms of insurance as required by the City.

DISCUSSION:

The last IGA lapsed in May of 2022. We are submitting a new IGA approved this school year by the Douglas School District Board which will lapse May 16, 2025.
