TML nor any other insurer can rely on past patterns and trends to predict future losses. TML recently created a new Cyber Fund and approved changes to the

Pool's Coverage structure, effective on October 1, 2024.

Members must elect to continue coverage or "opt-in" by completing and returning the Cyber Interlocal Agreement to participate in the newly created

Cyber Fund.

This agreement is to accept the new coverage. The cost is \$1,250 a year.
