Agenda Item Wording: **Approval of a Donation Agreement between the City of Dripping Springs and Girl Scout Silver Award Candidate Autumn Pope regarding renovations to Charro Ranch Park's Informational Kiosk.**

Agenda Item Requestor: Autumn Pope

Summary/Background: To earn their Silver Award, girl scouts must lead one project (equaling 50 hours or more) that will have lasting impact on the community. The Scouts have until December 31st to complete their project. Autumn Pope hopes to update and restore the Charro Ranch Kiosk because it lacks in relevant information about the park. The Parks and Community Services Department will oversee the execution of the project; however, Ms. Pope will be responsible for the project at hand. In the restoration, she will include interpretive signage to make it more accessible, any necessary repairs, and information regarding the park such as vegetation and wildlife.
