RE: COA Application Fees

I. COA Application Fee Findings

On June 4, 2026, the Historic Preservation Commission requested that the Planning Department conduct research on fees for COA applications. The purpose of this request is to adopt COA permit fees. Although the City of Dripping Springs waives COA application permit fees for property owners that comply with the City of Dripping Springs' Historic Preservation and Historic District Ordinance, violators will be required to pay these fees once the City of Dripping Springs Historic Preservation Ordinance revision is adopted in the future.

Staff compiled research on COA application fees for 13 cities in the State of Texas, in order to gather a baseline for the range of fees that are currently charged throughout the following jurisdictions:

6. Georgetown
7. Fort Worth
8. Boerne
