Agenda Item Wording: Discuss and consider approval of the Proposed Ad Valorem Tax Rate for 2026. Deputy City Administrator, Shawn Cox

Agenda Item Requestor:

Summary/Background:

The City's current Ad Valorem Tax Rate is set at \$.2267 per one-hundred dollars (\$100.00) valuation. The Current rate is the sum of the City's Maintenance and Operations (M&O) and Interest and Sinking (I&S/Debt) rates:

Rate	Adopted
M&O	\$0.1850
I&S/Debt	\$0.0418
Total	\$0.2267

For consideration is the approval of the proposed tax rate for 2026. At the time of posting, the City has not received its 2026 Tax Rate Calculation Worksheet, which will calculate the "No-revenue", Voter-approval" and "De minimis" tax rates. Historically, the City has adopted the "Voter-approval tax rate." The completed calculation worksheet is anticipated to be delivered prior to the Council meeting. Once a proposed rate is approved, the next step will be to post the public hearing notice.

FY 2026 was the first year Council adopted an I&S (Debt) Tax Rate, based on issuances from 2024 and 2025. The impact to the rate for FY 2027 is broken down below. The total I&S Rate calculated for FY 2027 is \$0.04612/\$100 valuation.
