

Hi Bill,

I wanted to reach out and express my concerns regarding the pump and haul proposal for the Tri Pointe development.

As a nearby property owner, I share many of the same concerns that my neighbor Daniel raised. The idea of a pump and haul operation potentially remaining in place until 2028 or beyond does not seem like an appropriate long-term solution.

My wife and I have three young children who ride their bikes and play throughout our neighborhood, right near the proposed location. The thought of years of increased truck traffic, noise, and the potential impacts that come with a pump and haul operation is concerning to us as a family and as residents of this community.

I understand that growth is coming to Dripping Springs and that development is inevitable. However, I believe growth should follow infrastructure, not precede it. If permanent wastewater infrastructure is not yet available, I do not believe a temporary solution that could remain in place for several years is the right path forward.

I respectfully ask that the City Council deny the pump and haul request and require a permanent wastewater solution before the development proceeds.
