Summary/Background:	<ul> <li>Several Commissioners expressed interest in creating a memorial downtown in recognition of Brenda Medcalf's fourteen years of service to the Founders Day Commission. Possible memorial options and associated costs are as follows:</li> <li>Dedication of a new bench in a City park: \$2,000 <ul> <li>Includes bench and plaque</li> </ul> </li> <li>Dedication of a tree in a City park: \$2,000 <ul> <li>Includes tree planting and plaque</li> </ul> </li> <li>Dedication of an existing bench downtown: \$2,500 <ul> <li>50% discount approved by City Council: \$1,250</li> </ul> </li> <li>Dedication of a planned bench in the new pedestrian alley near the downtown restrooms in "Stephenson Way" <ul> <li>50% discount approved by City Council: \$1,250</li> </ul> </li> <li>Funding for such a memorial may not be allocated from the FDC budget or event sponsorship, and must be donated for this specific purpose. For instance, 25 individuals could donate \$50 each. A pledge of \$75 has already been made.</li> </ul>
Staff Recommendations: Next Steps/Schedule:	<ul> <li>Staff recommends selecting an undedicated bench downtown on Mercer or on Stephenson Way and add a dedication plaque in Brenda Medcalf's honor.</li> <li>1.
