RESOLUTION No. 2025-R

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF DRIPPING SPRINGS, TEXAS APPROVING AND ADOPTING THE 2025 HAZARDOUS MITIGATION PLAN.

- WHEREAS, the Federal Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 amended the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act (Stafford Act), creating the framework for state, local, tribal, and territorial governments to engage in hazard mitigation planning to receive certain types of non-emergency disaster assistance; and
- **WHEREAS**, the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 was amended in May 2023 to require an Active Hazard Mitigation Plan for federal grant funding eligibility; and
- WHEREAS, a Core Team comprised of members of Hays County, participating sub-jurisdictions, and school districts took part in the identification of Critical Facilities, Community Capabilities, Identification and Prioritization of Natural Hazard Risks, and the identification of new Hazard Mitigation Actions; and
- **WHEREAS**, the City of Dripping Springs commits to comply with the annual Plan review as described by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA); and,
- **WHEREAS**, the Plan attached as Attachment "A" incorporates the comments, ideas, and concerns of the communities, which this updated Plan is designed to protect, ascertained through a series of Public Outreach Meetings, newspaper coverage, publication of the draft plan for public review and comment, and other activities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DRIPPING SPRINGS, TEXAS:

- **1. Finding of Fact:** The above and foregoing recitals are hereby found to be true and correct and are incorporated as finding of fact.
- **2. Adoption:** The 2025 Hazard Mitigation Plan update is hereby approved and adopted following final approval by FEMA, and the City of Dripping Springs resolves to execute the Actions in the Plan.
- 3. Effective Date: The resolution shall be effective from and after its approval and passage.
- **4. Meeting:** The meeting at which this Resolution was passed was open to the public, and that public notice of the time, place, and purpose of said meeting was given as required by the Open Meetings Act, Texas Government Code, Chapter 551.
