**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF DRIPPING SPRINGS  
CONSENTING TO THE CITY OF DRIPPING SPRINGS WATER  
CONSERVATION PLAN**

**WHEREAS,** the City of Dripping Springs water conservation plan has been developed to meet the LCRA Water Conservation Plan Rules for Water Sale Contracts in accordance with the LCRA Water Contract Rules; and

**WHEREAS,** this plan recognizes that conservation is a valuable tool in managing water utility systems; and

**WHEREAS,** benefits of water conservation include: extending available water supplies; reducing the risk of shortage during periods of extreme drought; reducing water utility operating cost; improving the reliability and quality of water utility service; reducing customer cost for water service; and enhancing water quality and the environment; and

**WHEREAS,** pursuant to Texas Local Government Code Section 51.001, the City has general authority to adopt an ordinance or police regulation that is for the good government, peace or order of the City and is necessary or proper for carrying out a power granted by law to the City; and

**WHEREAS,** the City Council finds that it is necessary and proper for the good government, peace or order of the City to approve this Resolution.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DRIPPING SPRINGS, as follows:**

**Section 1.** This meeting of the City Council of the City of Dripping Springs has been properly posted in accordance with the Texas Open Meetings Act.

**Section 2.** The City Council of the City of Dripping Springs hereby approves the City of Dripping Springs Water Conservation Plan.

**Section 3.** This Resolution shall be effective upon the date of its approval.
