**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF DRIPPING SPRINGS
CONSENTING TO DROUGHT CONTINGENCY PLAN FOR
MUNICIPAL WATER USE**

WHEREAS, The Lower Colorado River Authority (LCRA) provides contracts to customers for water supply; and

WHEREAS, in cases of drought, periods of abnormally high usage or system contamination, or extended reduction in ability to supply water due to equipment failure, LCRA may require water customers to institute temporary restrictions to limit nonessential water usage; and

WHEREAS, this Drought Contingency Plan (Plan) is designed to protect the available water supply and protect the integrity of water supply facilities, with regard for domestic water use, sanitation and fire protection during these periods or other water supply emergencies; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Texas Local Government Code Section 51.001, the City has general authority to adopt an ordinance or police regulation that is for the good government, peace or order of the City and is necessary or proper for carrying out a power granted by law to the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that it is necessary and proper for the good government, peace or order of the City to approve this Resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DRIPPING SPRINGS, as follows:

Section 1. This meeting of the City Council of the City of Dripping Springs has been properly posted in accordance with the Texas Open Meetings Act.

Section 2. The City Council of the City of Dripping Springs hereby approves the Drought Contingency Plan for municipal water use.

Section 3. This Resolution shall be effective upon the date of its approval.
