Summary/Background:	As part of the City's ongoing efforts to enhance visitor experience, support local businesses, and improve traffic flow and connectivity, the need for a cohesive wayfinding signage system has been identified. A well-designed wayfinding program will help guide residents and visitors to key destinations including City Hall, the Visitor Center, historic Mercer Street and shops, parks, trails and other sites.
	City staff has reviewed similar programs in peer cities and has been working with Studio 16:19 on design and implementation. We have our final design that was also approved by TxDOT. Studio 16:19 also worked on park signage, so the designs will complement each other and follow the brand guideline. This bid package will allow the City to now seek proposals from qualified firms with expertise to create and install the signage.
	<b>Budget:</b> Half of the funding for the wayfinding signage installation package is included in the approved FY 2024-2025 Hotel Tax budget. The remaining amount is currently in the draft FY 2025-2026 budget. Staff will ensure that proposals fall within allocated funds and will bring a final contract to Council for approval before any work begins.
