OF THE CITY OF DRIPPING SPRINGS
PROCLAIMING SEPTEMBER 17 – SEPTEMBER 23, 2026, AS**

“CONSTITUTION WEEK”

- WHEREAS,** The Constitution of the United States of America, the guardian of our liberties, embodies the principles of limited government in a Republic dedicated to rule by law; and
- WHEREAS,** September 17, 2026, marks the two hundred and thirty-ninth anniversary of the framing of the Constitution of the United States of America by the Constitutional Convention; and
- WHEREAS,** It is fitting and proper to accord official recognition to this magnificent document and its memorable anniversary, and to the patriotic celebrations which will commemorate it; and
- WHEREAS,** Public Law 915 guarantees the issuing of a proclamation each year by the President of the United States of America designating September 17 through 23 as Constitution Week; and
- WHEREAS,** Constitution Week serves as a reminder of the importance of civic knowledge, public participation, and continued commitment to the principles of self-government upon which our nation was founded.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED by the City Council of Dripping Springs, Texas:

- 1.** That September 17 - September 23, 2026 shall hereafter be known as “Constitution Week” in Dripping Springs, Hays County, Texas
- 2.** The City of Dripping Springs City Council calls upon all of our citizens to reaffirm the ideals the Framers of the Constitution had in 1787 by vigilantly protect the freedoms guaranteed to us through this guardian of our liberties.
