Re: Proclamation for Constitution Week, September 17-23, 2026

As we celebrate America 250, we also celebrate the enduring legacy of the U.S. Constitution, which transformed the ideals proclaimed in 1776 into a lasting framework of liberty, self-government, and service to our nation. The National Society of the Daughters of the American Revolution have been tasked to publicly celebrate and promote the Constitution since a resolution to do so was signed into law by President Dwight D. Eisenhower in 1956. The Sarah Pound Chapter, NSDAR would be honored to partner with the City of Dripping Springs to have a public proclamation for this important event.

WHEREAS: The Constitution of the United States of America, the guardian of our liberties, embodies the principles of limited government in a Republic dedicated to rule by law; and

WHEREAS: September 17, 2026, marks the two hundred and thirty-ninth anniversary of the framing of the Constitution of the United States of America by the Constitutional Convention; and

WHEREAS: It is fitting and proper to accord official recognition to this magnificent document and its memorable anniversary, and to the patriotic celebrations which will commemorate it; and

WHEREAS: Public Law 915 guarantees the issuing of a proclamation each year by the President of the United States of America designating September 17 through 23 as Constitution Week,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED by the City Council of Dripping Springs, Texas:

1. That September 17 - September 23, 2026 shall hereafter be known as "Constitution Week" in Dripping Springs, Hays County, Texas

2. The City of Dripping Springs City Council calls upon all of our citizens to reaffirm the ideals the Framers of the Constitution had in 1787 by vigilantly protect the freedoms guaranteed to us through this guardian of our liberties.
