## ADDENDUM TO MASTER SUBSCRIPTION AGREEMENT

- 3. Mandatory Disclosures: Texas law requires that vendors make certain disclosures. Prior to the effective date of this Contract, the Contractor has submitted to the City a copy of the Conflict-of-Interest Questionnaire form (CIQ Form) approved by the Texas Ethics Commission (Texas Local Government Code Chapter 176). Prior to the effective date of this Contract, the Contractor must fill out Form 1295, as required by the Texas Ethics Commission, and submit it to the City.
