3. Approve Final Plat of Nature Trail Addition, Dubuque County, Iowa. Lot 1 of Koelker Place and Lot 2 of Steffensmeier Place No. 2, all in Dubuque County, Iowa. Plat submitted by Daniel Helle and Chris Tallman.

Dave Schneider, surveyor, was present and stated he worked with Tallman's and Helle's on the building of Helle's house on Lot 1. It was agreed that Helle would get an access easement through Tallman's property in exchange Helle would sell Tallman some land. Schneider said

the property is within 2 miles of Dyersville, and the County is meeting on the rezoning and approval of the plat.

City Administrator Mick Michel stated the plat conforms to standards in that area, so he has no issues with the plat.

4. Recommendation on City Initiated Text Amendment to Section 160.09.11 of the City Zoning Regulations.

City Administrator Mick Michel stated the city council has sent this to the Commission in order to amend the city fence ordinance. He stated there are gaps regarding the definition of a temporary or portable fence. The Commission needs to provide a positive or negative report back to the city council.

Michel stated the city wants to correct the definition of a temporary or movable fence. The city is seeing more movable fences and wants to treat them all the same. More definition is needed especially for front yard temporary fencing. The city does not want to see temporary fencing in the front yards.

Michel said in summary, the city wants better definitions and more restrictions on temporary fencing. A definition of a temporary fence is one that is not permanently installed and has a time limit. It would not require a permit. An example would be a snow fence.

Commission member Westhoff asked how many fence permits the city receives. Michel stated approximately 15-20. Michel also stated there would be better code enforcement with better definitions.

There was no further discussion regarding the City Initiated Text Amendment to Section 160.09.11 of the City Zoning Regulations.
