

RESOLUTION NUMBER 22-26

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE INSURANCE SCHEDULE POLICY FOR THE CITY OF
DYERSVILLE

WHEREAS, the City of Dyersville is authorized under Iowa Code Chapter 364 to adopt policies necessary and proper for the governance of city affairs and the protection of the health, safety, and welfare of the public; and,

WHEREAS, Iowa Code Section 364.4 authorizes cities to assess and manage risk, and the City regularly enters into contracts, leases, licenses, permits, and agreements that expose the City to potential liability; and,

WHEREAS, the City Administrator has prepared an Insurance Schedule Policy establishing minimum insurance requirements for all parties doing business with the City of Dyersville, including twenty (20) schedules covering lessees, contractors, vendors, special events, professional services, haulers, marina operators, and other categories of risk; and,

WHEREAS, the Insurance Schedule Policy requires that the City of Dyersville, including all its elected and appointed officials, employees, volunteers, boards, commissions, and authorities, be named as an Additional Insured, and that each applicable schedule include a Preservation of Governmental Immunities Endorsement consistent with Iowa Code Section 670.4; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council has reviewed the Insurance Schedule Policy and finds that its adoption is in the best interest of the City of Dyersville and its residents; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
DYERSVILLE, IOWA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council hereby adopts the attached Insurance Schedule Policy, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated by reference.

Section 2. The City Administrator is hereby authorized and directed to administer the Insurance Schedule Policy, including the review and approval of certificates of insurance, the modification of individual schedules as provided in the Policy, and the enforcement of insurance requirements for all parties doing business with the City.

Section 3. This Resolution shall be made a matter of public record.
