Students were asked to fill out a survey when they were done. Here are some results:

97 out of 77 students have a job (79%). 9 have 2 jobs and 1 student have 4 jobs.

20 students don't have a job with the #1 reason being they don't have enough time with school, followed by they were in sports. 3 are currently looking for a job.

57 of them rely on word of mouth on how to find a job or their parents. Social media also plays a factor – Facebook and Instagram were top 2 ways to find a job. Not so much by snapchat or tiktok. Indeed was the #1 site they go to if they were to look for a job online.

12 are not leaving

38 after college/training

8 after they have kids

9 never moving back

34 don't know if they will move back.

Most surprising thing students said they learned at Real Life Academy:


- There were a lot of expenses I didn't know about.




