This letter serves as a follow-up to my correspondence dated February 27, 2026, regarding the sewer backup claim filed by Quincy Wilgenbusch and Savannah Salow. Mayor Jacque requested that I provide the Council with a brief update on this issue. This letter is for informational purposes only, and no action is required from the City Council at this time.


Since my last letter, the property owners submitted a public records request for documents related to the City's sewer manholes and sewer mains extending from their property to the main crossing Bear Creek and ending at the manhole at Westside Park. The City has provided all the requested documents, and the property owners have received them.

We also sent these same materials to EMC Insurance for their review as part of their ongoing investigation. The City contacted EMC to confirm receipt of the additional information, and EMC acknowledged receipt of the materials.

On March 9, 2026, City staff and Mayor Jacque met with the property owners to demonstrate the City's Asset Management software. During that meeting, I guided the property owners through each asset requested as part of their records request. The city aimed to be transparent and responsive to their concerns, while also safeguarding the security of the City's overall infrastructure. I believe we achieved the right balance.

Since that meeting, an EMC adjuster has contacted our Public Works Director and reached out to me with several follow-up questions. I will keep monitoring this issue and report back to the Council if I receive any additional updates.
