A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING THE CITY  
ADMINISTRATOR TO EXPEND FUNDS FROM THE CAPITAL PROJECTS FUND  
FOR STREET RECONSTRUCTION EXPENSES ON 6TH STREET SE ALLEY

WHEREAS, the City of Dyersville has identified a need for street reconstruction on 6th Street SE, specifically between 6th and 7th Avenue SE, including alley approach, sidewalk repairs, and curb repairs; and,

WHEREAS, this project is identified as Pavement Asset 1003 and Task 61220; and,

WHEREAS, the total cost of the project shall not exceed \$8,000 and shall be funded from the Capital Projects Fund; and,

WHEREAS, proposals from F.L. Krapfl, Inc. have been received for work on two alleys in the southeast part of town to correct stormwater runoff issues; and,

WHEREAS, urban pavement with curb-and-gutter is designed to convey stormwater into intakes and storm sewers and away from private property, and driveway aprons are a critical part of this system; and,

WHEREAS, Pavement Asset 1003 has been identified where stormwater is flowing into private backyards due to inadequate alley aprons; and,

WHEREAS, installing proper driveway aprons will correct this issue and ensure proper drainage during heavy rains; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Dyersville, Iowa, that the City Administrator is hereby authorized and approved to expend an amount not to exceed \$8,000 from the Capital Projects Fund for the street reconstruction expenses described herein.
