Unfortunately, no officers were able to be present for the meeting.

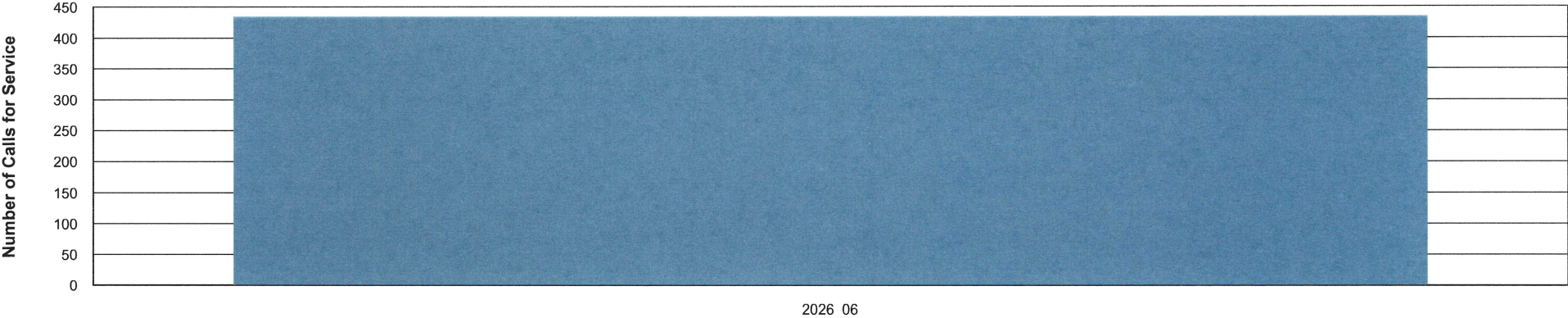

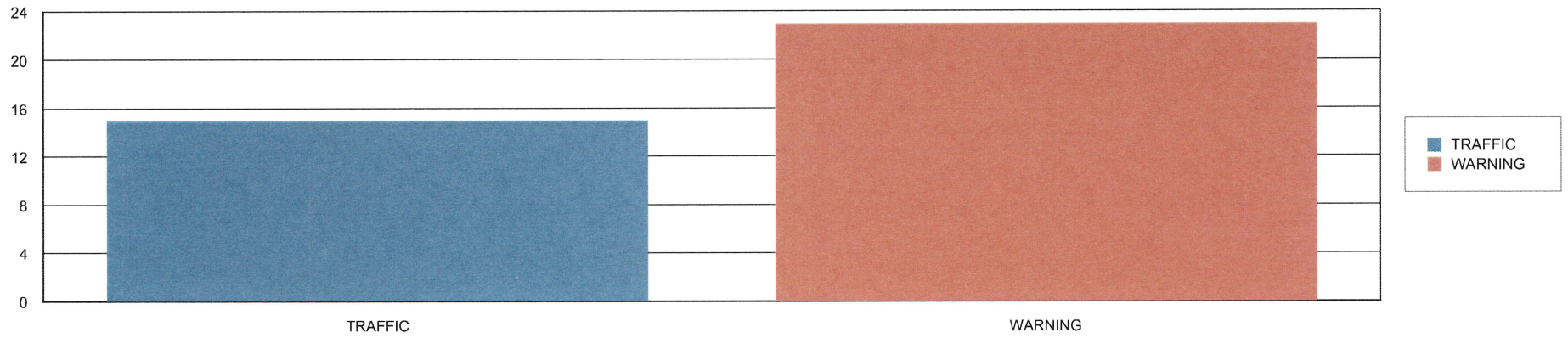

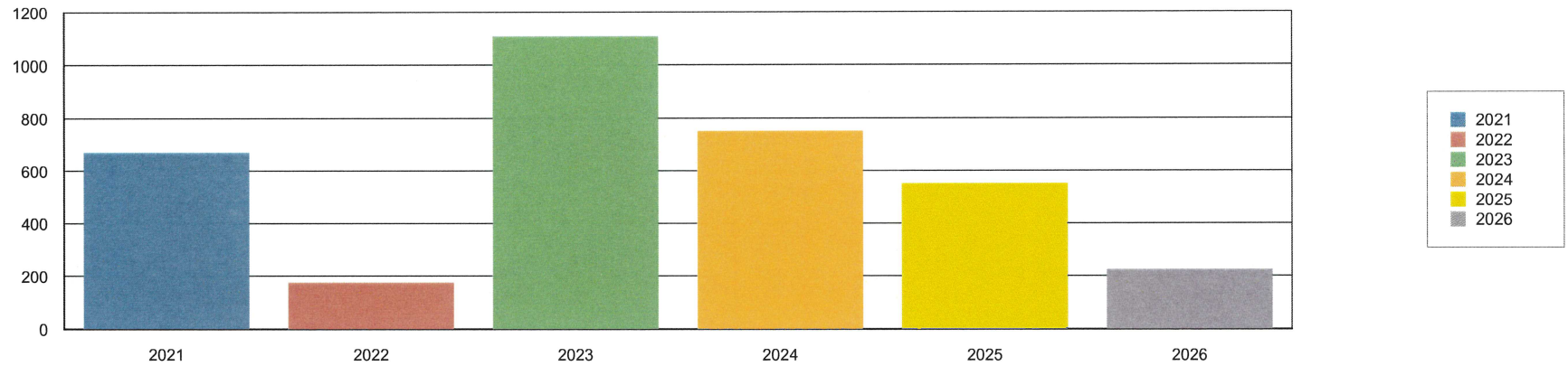
