

RESOLUTION NO. 67-26

A RESOLUTION AWARDING THE CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT FOR THE OLDE CASTLE ROAD SANITARY SEWER EXTENSION 2026 PROJECT

WHEREAS, under Iowa Code Chapter 26, the City may award a public improvement contract by competitive quotation when the estimated cost of the improvement falls within the competitive quotation range established by law; and,

WHEREAS, the City solicited competitive quotations for the Olde Castle Road Sanitary Sewer Extension 2026 Project and received three (3) quotations, which were opened on July 8, 2026, at 3:00 p.m.; and,

WHEREAS, the quotations were tabulated and reviewed, and the lowest responsive and responsible quotation, in the amount of \$68,930.00, was submitted by F.L. Krapfl, Inc. of Dyersville, Iowa; and,

WHEREAS, the City Engineer/Public Works Director has determined that F.L. Krapfl, Inc. has the experience, equipment, and workforce to complete the Project, and has recommended award of the contract to F.L. Krapfl, Inc. as the lowest responsive and responsible quotation received; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that awarding the contract to F.L. Krapfl, Inc. for the Project is necessary, advisable, and in the best interest of the City and its residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Dyersville, Iowa, as follows:

SECTION 1. Award of Contract. The contract for the Olde Castle Road Sanitary Sewer Extension 2026 Project is hereby awarded to F.L. Krapfl, Inc. of Dyersville, Iowa, in the amount of \$68,930.00, as the lowest responsive and responsible quotation received.

SECTION 2. Basis of Settlement. Final settlement shall be based on the unit prices set out in the contractor's quotation and the actual final quantities of each item of work furnished, subject to the plans and specifications for the Project and the terms of the contractor's written proposal.

SECTION 3. Authorization to Execute. The Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute a written contract with F.L. Krapfl, Inc. for the Project.

SECTION 4. Bonds and Insurance. Prior to execution of the contract, the contractor shall furnish the performance and payment bonds and certificates of insurance required by the contract documents and by law.

SECTION 5. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and adoption.
