5/15 2nd Tobacco Compliance Check

Chief Schroeder and Asst Chief Tuegel attended the meeting, in which we got our app up and running in test mode. June 1st was our goal to go live, so this gave us a brief period to test for problems.

5/25 American Legion Ceremony

Officer Jobgen attended the ceremony.

5/26-27 Firearms Qualification

All officers re-certified on their duty weapons, which is required by Iowa law. This also gave us the chance to certify Officer Segebart on his duty weapon.

Chief Schroeder, Asst Chief Tuegel and Officers Jobgen and Segebart meet with a representative of the Mid-States Organized Crime Information Center about changes to our membership and the new services they can provide.

Officer Segebart has completed all the requirements for hire. He is now riding with each of the officers and learning the roads and our computer programs. He has definitely hit the ground running and should be in his own vehicle soon. We're expecting the field training program to take at least a couple of months.

The department was approved for a Bullet Proof Vest Grant from the Bureau of Justice Assistance. The grant was in the amount of \$3308.39. This will provide for 50% of the cost for two new vests. Several of our officers are either getting new vests or are at the end of the life cycle for their vests, so this will certainly help. I have attached a copy of the notification letter.

We are also in the final stages of ordering a new police truck. We are comparing the Ford F150 and Chevrolet Silverado, as RAM trucks are no longer being made in police package. We will most likely order in the next week or two, as the window for ordering 2026s is closing.

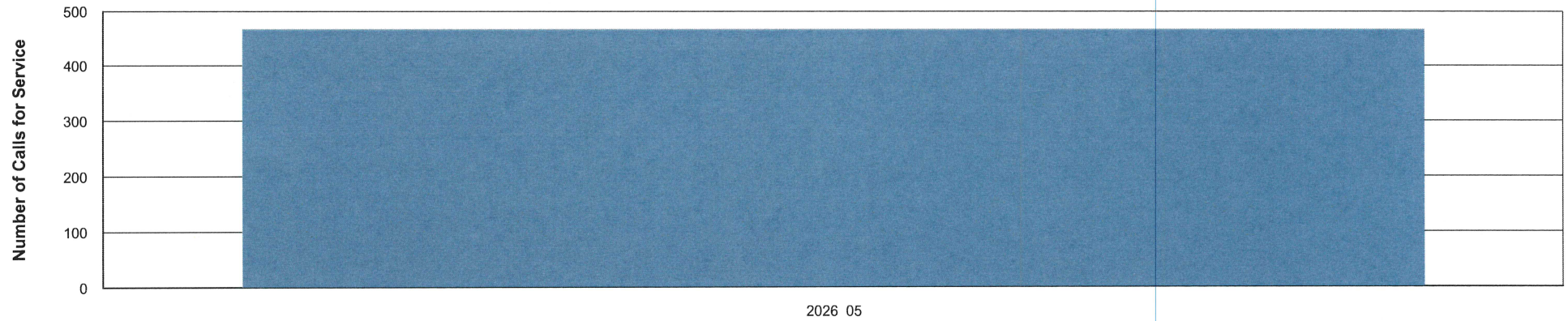

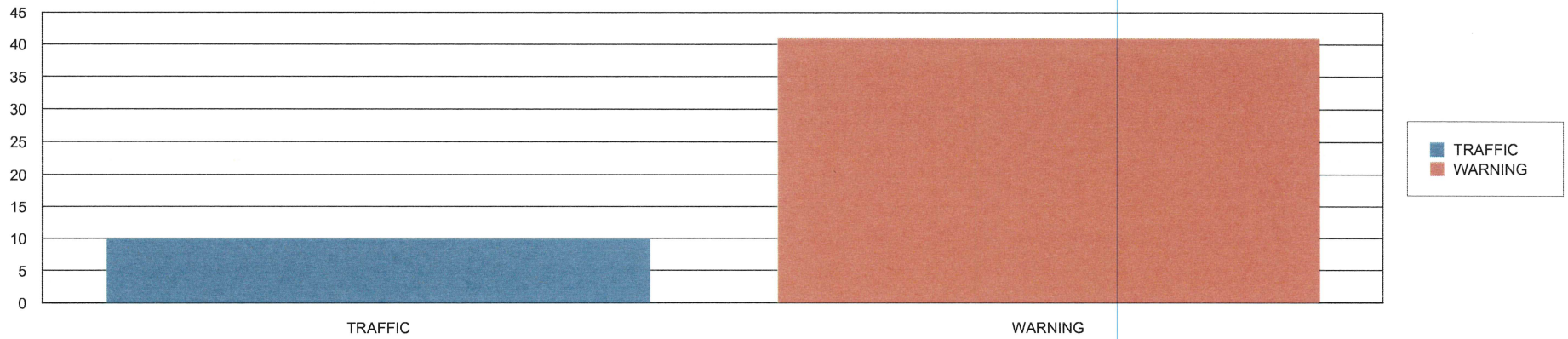

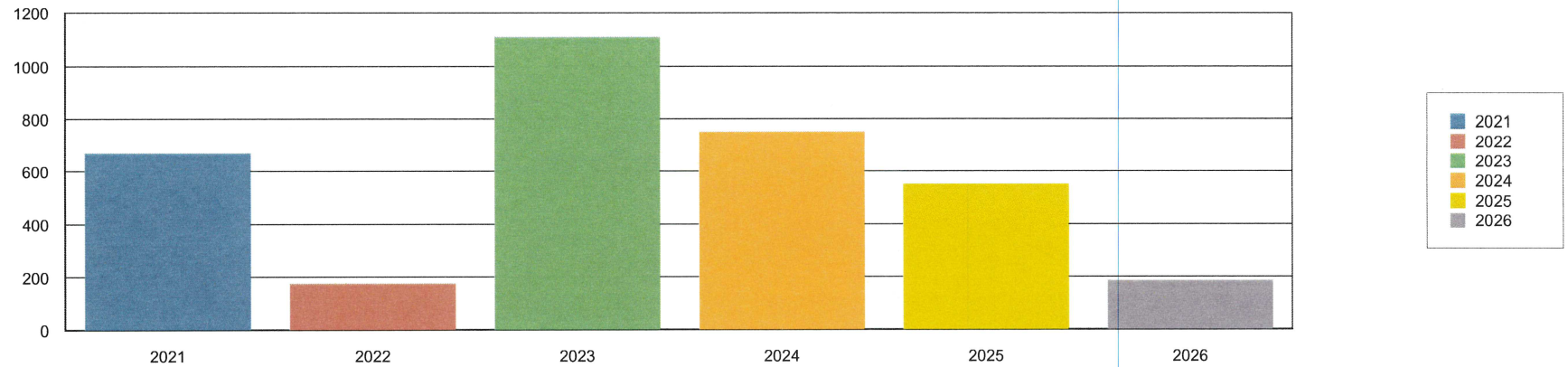

Dear Applicant,

The Office of Justice Programs' Bureau of Justice Assistance (BJA) is pleased to inform you that your jurisdiction will receive an award under the fiscal year (FY) 2025 Bulletproof Vest Partnership (BVP) program. These funds have been posted to your account in the [BVP System](https://bja.ojp.gov/funding/fy25-bvp-awards.pdf). A complete list of FY 2025 BVP awards is available online here: <https://bja.ojp.gov/funding/fy25-bvp-awards.pdf>.

Important: Jurisdictions *must* be registered and include updated banking information in the [System for Award Management \(SAM\)](https://sam.gov/content/help) to receive reimbursement.

For more information about renewing and updating your existing SAM registration, or registering in SAM as a new entity, please visit <https://sam.gov/content/help>.

The FY 2025 award may be used for National Institute of Justice (NIJ) compliant armored vests which were ordered after April 1, 2025. The deadline to request payments from the FY 2025 award is August 31, 2027 or until all available funds have been requested. Awards will not be extended past that date, and any unused funds will be forfeited.

As a reminder, body armor vests purchased with BVP funds must have been tested through the NIJ [Compliance Testing Program](#) and found to comply with the most current NIJ body armor standards, appear on the [NIJ Compliant Products List](#) as of the date the body armor was ordered, be uniquely fitted, and be made in the United States. In addition, a written mandatory wear policy for uniformed patrol officers must have been in place at the time of application.

The federal portion of the costs for body armor vests purchased under the BVP Program may not exceed 50 percent. However, jurisdictions may request a financial or natural disaster hardship waiver during the payment request process and receive up to 100 percent of the cost of each body armor vest submitted for reimbursement. Additional

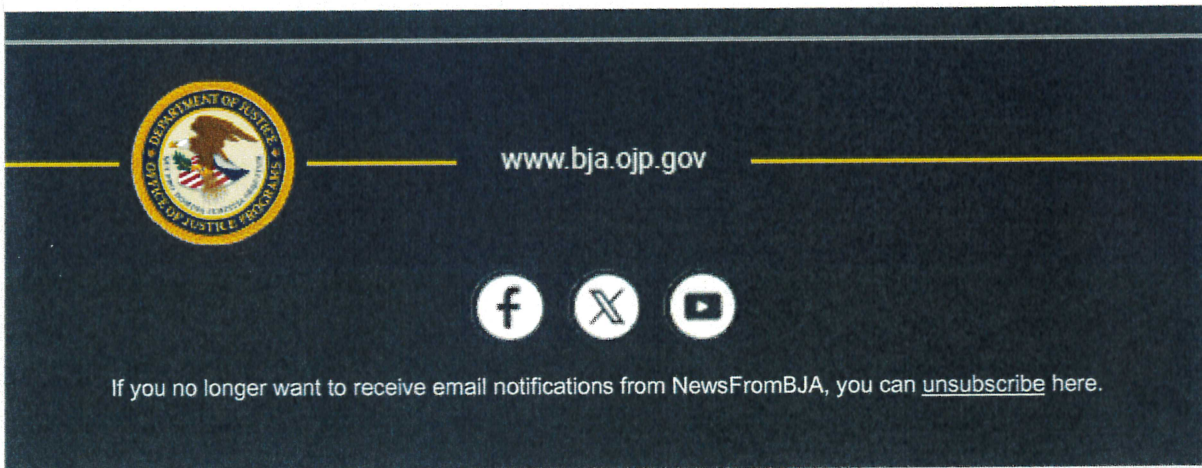
