

RESOLUTION NO. 54-26

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE DYERSVILLE SOUTHWEST STORMWATER IMPROVEMENTS CONCEPT DESIGN PREPARED BY EOCENE ENVIRONMENTAL GROUP

WHEREAS, the City of Dyersville is experiencing residential growth in the southwest area of the community, and the City has determined that the existing stormwater infrastructure in that area must be improved to manage water quantity, protect water quality, provide ecological benefits, and prepare the area for continued development; and,

WHEREAS, the City engaged Eocene Environmental Group of Coralville, Iowa, to evaluate existing conditions and prepare a concept design for stormwater improvements in the southwest area of Dyersville; and,

WHEREAS, Eocene Environmental Group has completed the Dyersville SW Stormwater Improvements Concept Design, dated June 5, 2026, which identifies four stormwater management practices: (A) an Enhanced Drainage Basin, (B) Drainageway Improvements and Connection to Tegeler Pond, (C) Drainageway Abandonment, and (D) a Tegeler Pond Outfall and Vegetated Swale; and,

WHEREAS, the concept design covers approximately 14.5 acres of previously disturbed land adjacent to 12th Avenue SW, 6th Avenue SW, and Tegeler Pond, and includes a conceptual opinion of probable cost of \$692,000 for the combined construction of all four practices; and,

WHEREAS, Eocene Environmental Group recommends constructing the four practices as a single combined project to balance earthwork across the sites, reduce mobilization costs, and minimize construction disruption to the area; and,

WHEREAS, approval of the concept design authorizes the City to proceed to final engineering design and does not commit the City to a specific funding source or construction contract, which will require separate Council action.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DYERSVILLE, IOWA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Approval of Concept Design. The Dyersville SW Stormwater Improvements Concept Design prepared by Eocene Environmental Group, dated June 5, 2026, is hereby approved.

SECTION 2. Authorization to Proceed. The City Administrator is authorized and directed to work with Eocene Environmental Group and City staff to advance the project to final engineering design.

SECTION 3. Future Council Action Required. Any contract for final design services or construction shall be brought to the City Council for approval prior to execution.

SECTION 4. Conflicting Provisions. All resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
