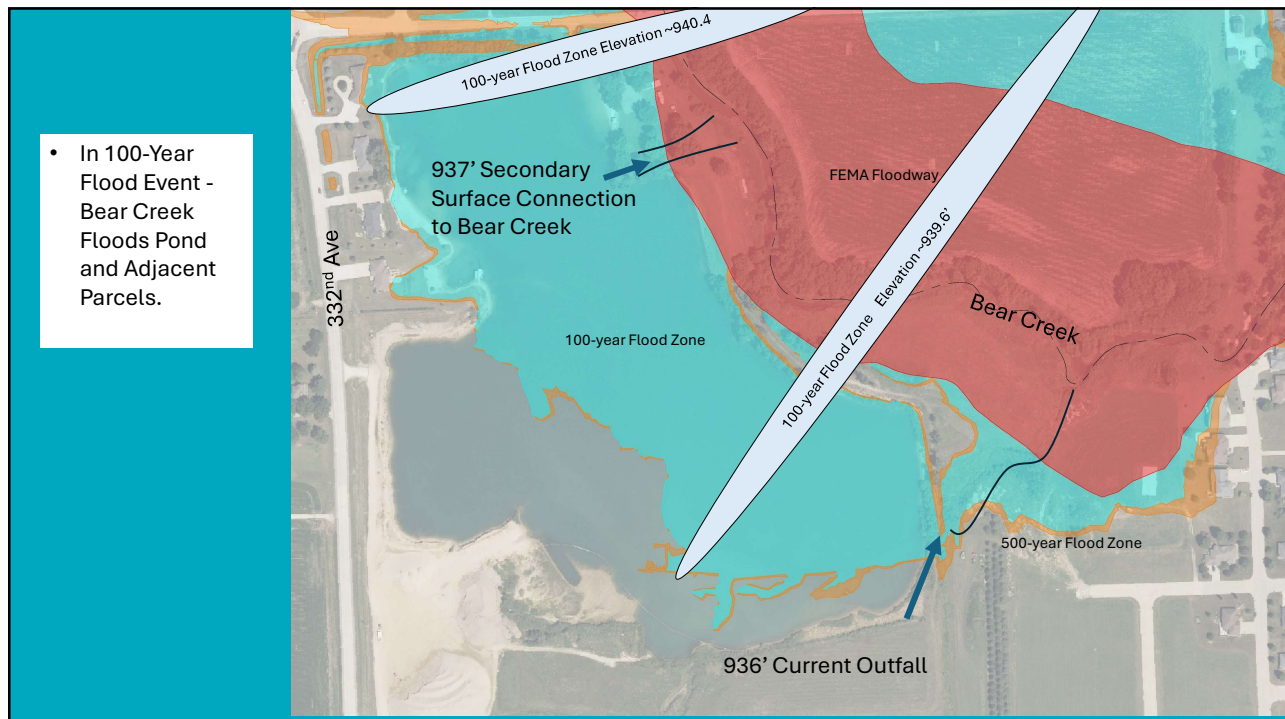


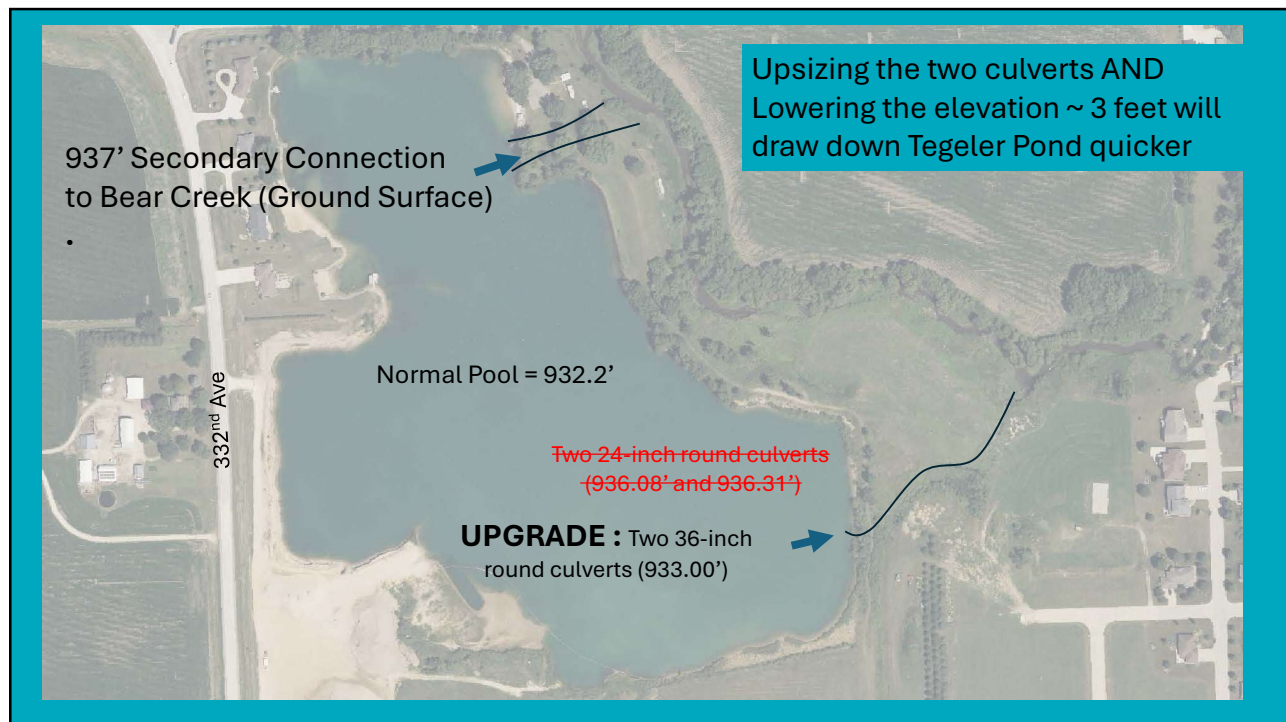
Restored Water Way









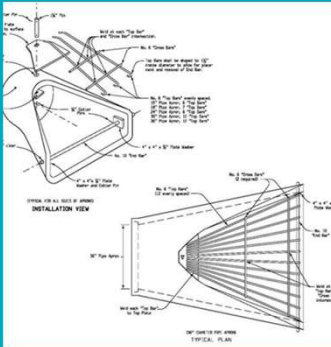


North Culvert – Appears Crushed



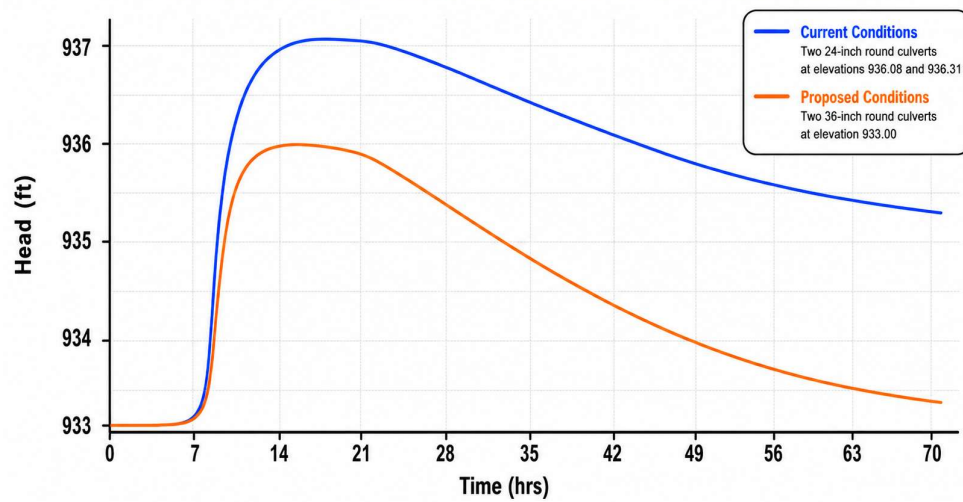


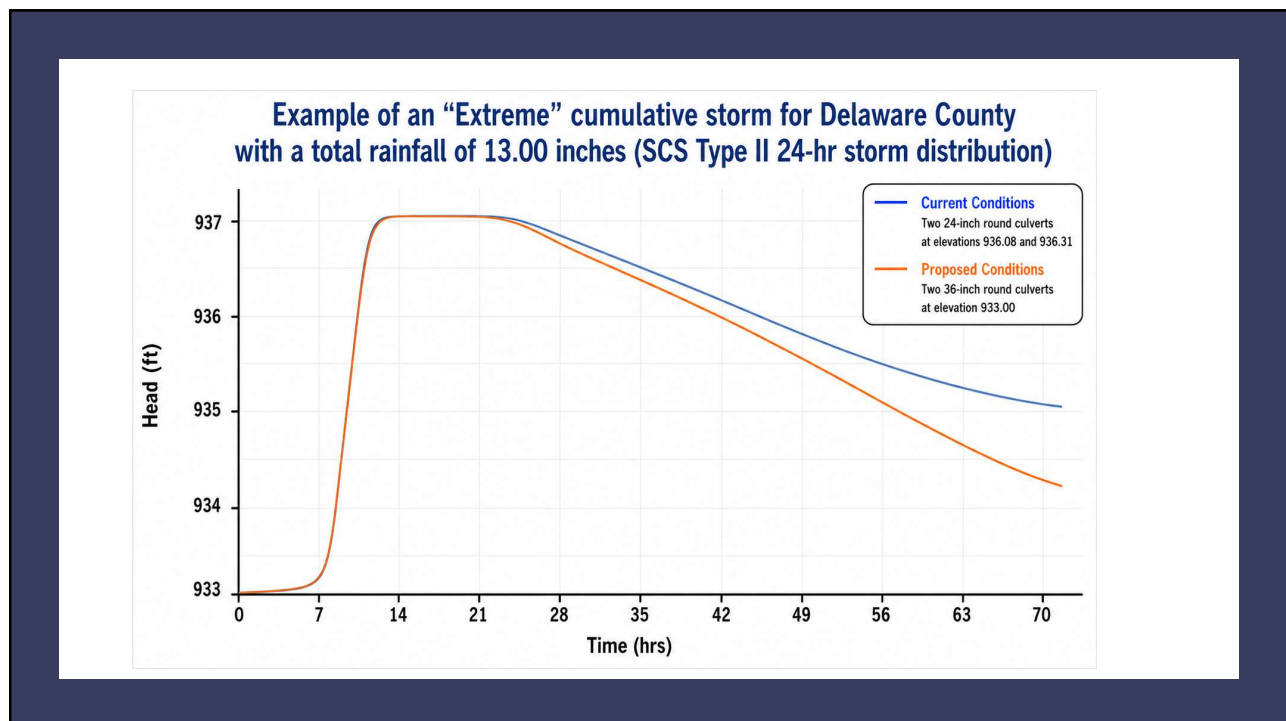
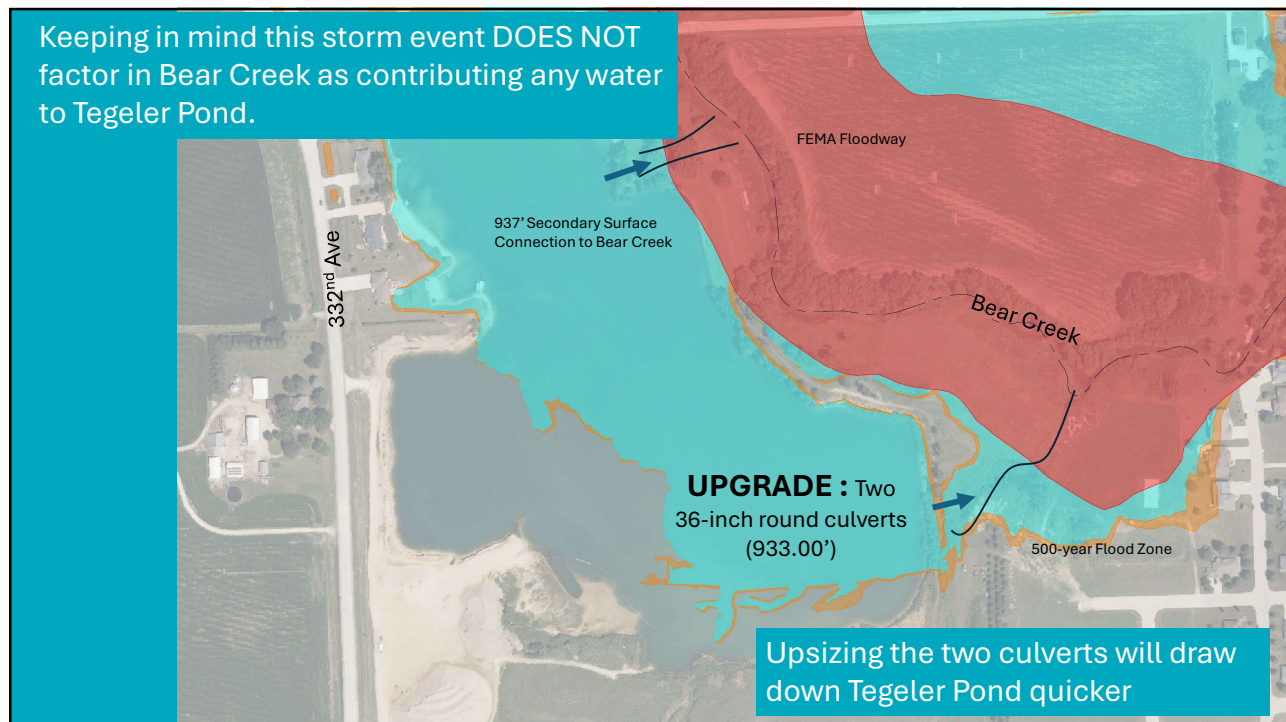
Existing Outfall
looking south

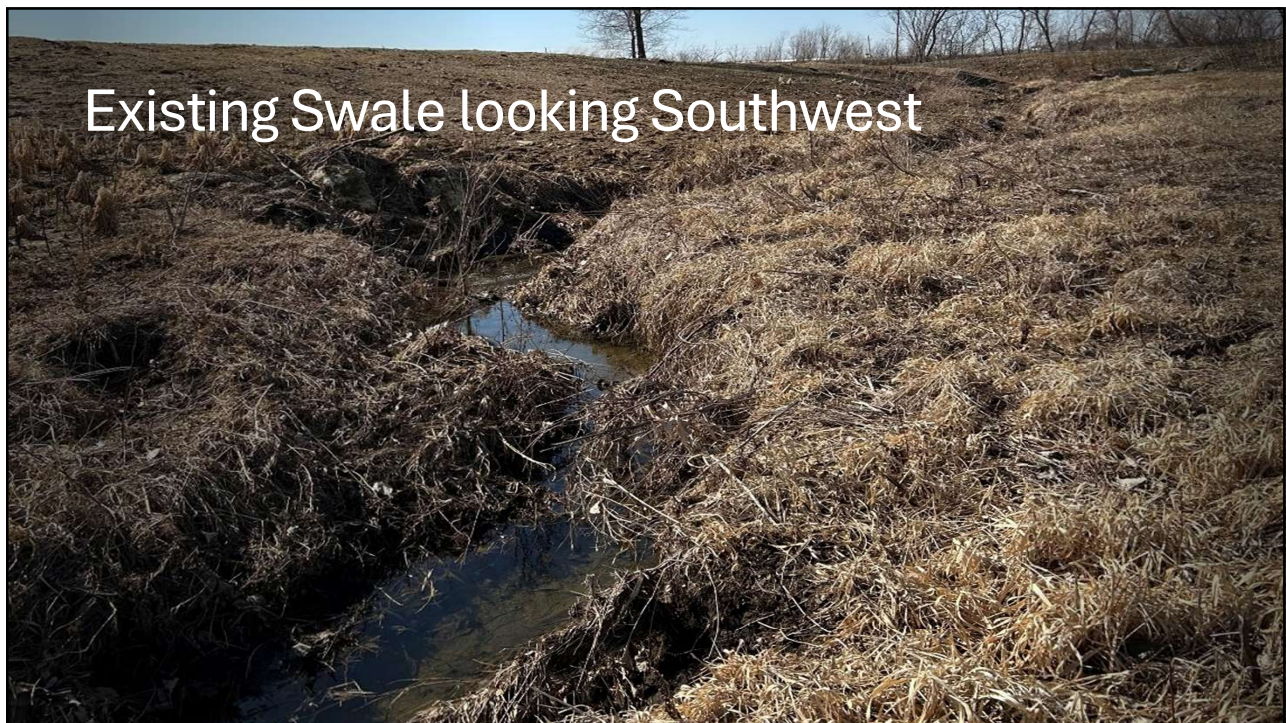
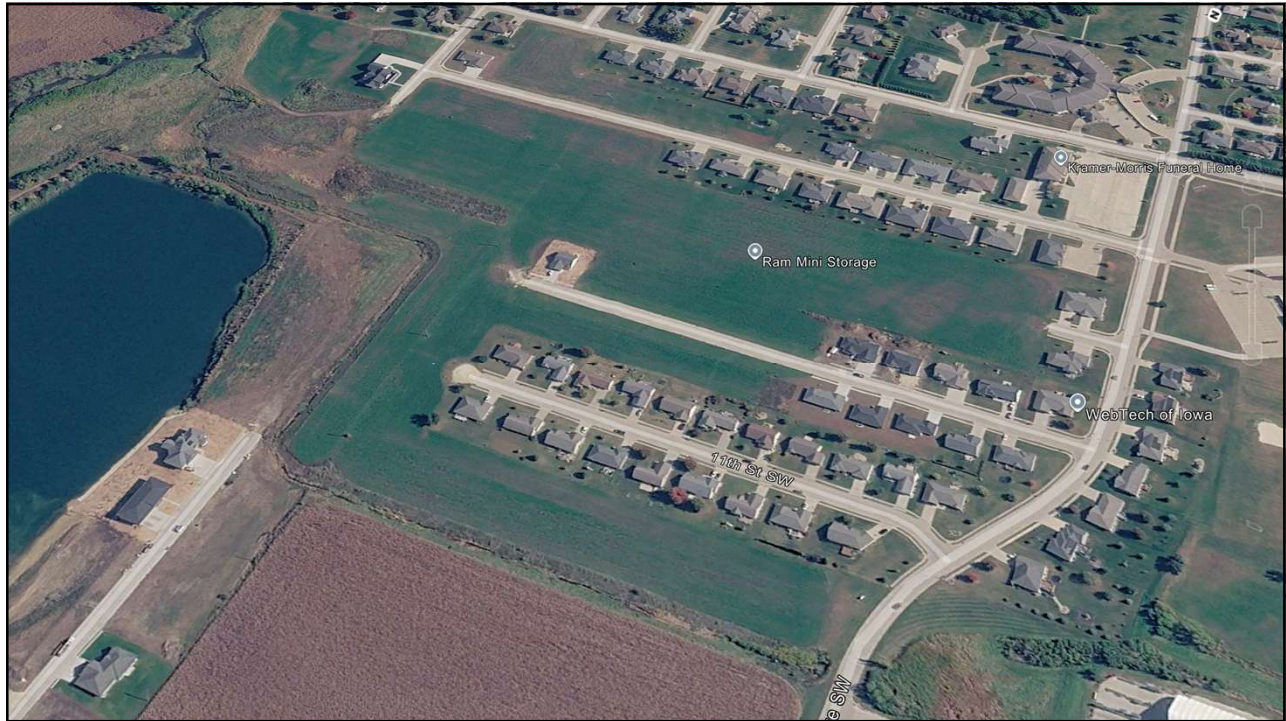


Proposed 36"

The 100-year cumulative storm for Delaware County with a total rainfall of 7.51 inches (SCS Type II 24-hr storm distribution)

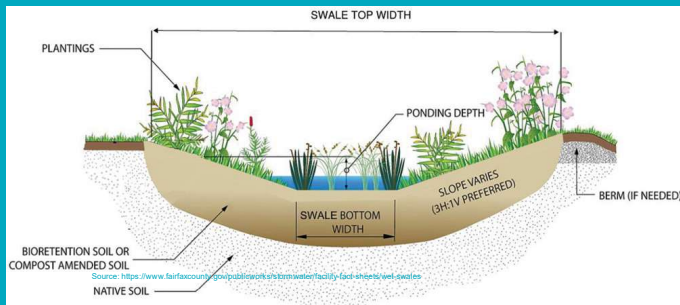






Existing Swale looking Southwest
