Chief Schroeder attended the Dubuque County 911 meeting.

Several agencies participated in a training day at the fire department where officers received a refresher class on OWI enforcement. The Iowa Department of Transportation also came to give tips and tricks for CDL law enforcement. Dementia Friends of Iowa presented training on ways to interact with individuals with different forms of dementia. Completion of this training certifies our department as a Dementia Friendly Department. Mobile Crisis gave a presentation and provided information on services that can they provide by partnering with us. We completed the day with TASER recertification at the PD Garage and rifle recertification at the shooting area.

Chief Schroeder met with Sheriff Kennedy to discuss staffing issues for 2026.

## **Dyersville PD—Timeline of events for ATM “Jack Potting” attempt.**

**Coralville and Cedar Rapids are hit earlier on the day on 10/31/25, with same MO and suspects.**

**11/1/25**

**0241 hours-suspect makes entry using a key to DU TRAC ATM off 16<sup>th</sup> AVE CT SE**

**Officer received hood alarm at 0253, arriving at 0255**

**ATM is found tampered with; contact meets with Police and video is reviewed.**

**One possible suspect is located on camera, and that is distributed to all the deputies. Dispatch and traffic cameras develop several suspects vehicles, and plates are obtained and entered into FLOCK.**

**At 0256, deputies located an open ATM hood in Farley at Mid-West One bank. That camera revealed the same suspect from Dyersville.**

**11/1/25**

**2330 hours, Peosta Police located one of the suspect vehicles at Kwik Stop in Peosta.**

**DYPD 8 sets up inside the Total fitness Rec Center in case the suspects return to withdrawal cash.**

**Unmarked units from Dubuque CO and Dubuque PD surveil now 2 suspect vehicles.**

**11/2/25**

**Shortly before 0100, unmarked vehicles advise both suspect vehicles are west on 20 toward Dyersville.**

**Just after 0100 both suspect vehicles pass Dyersville still west and are followed exiting into Earlville.**

**Dyersville, Dbq Co So, and Farley move toward Earlville as unmarked car witness suspects enter another ATM in Earlville.**

**Felony stops on both vehicles made on highway 20.**

**4 suspects in all are detained and arrested by Delaware Co for ATM tampering and held into Delaware CO jail.**

**11/4/25**

**Dyersville Officers applied and executed a search warrant on another vehicle involved in the jack potting, that was involved in an accident the night of the Earlville arrests.**

**Del Co executed search warrants on both suspect vehicles, which had electronics consistent with jack potting.**

**11/5/25**

**With the use of video obtained from Du Trac bank, City of Dubuque Street cameras, and Kwik Star on Dodge ST, DYPD was able to link 5 suspects and charge them all with conspiracy felony theft.**

**4 of these suspects have been taken into ICE custody.**

**11/9/25**

**Arrest warrants have been issued for the 5<sup>th</sup> suspect still outstanding, with nationwide extradition requested.**

**CASE NOTES:**

**Thanks to the information sharing of this major case, Officers had 4 suspects in custody within 24 hours of the first ATM being hit. Two of the suspects were confirmed Venezuelan gang members.**

**Dyersville officers had warrants and charges on 5 suspects, wrapping up this case in under 2 weeks' time.**






