

RESOLUTION NO. 60-26

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE IOWA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FEDERAL-AID AGREEMENT FOR A COMPETITIVE HIGHWAY BRIDGE PROGRAM PROJECT AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SIGN

WHEREAS, Iowa Code Sections 306A.7 and 307.44 authorize the City of Dyersville and the Iowa Department of Transportation to enter into agreements with each other for the purpose of financing transportation improvement projects on streets and highways in Iowa with Federal funds; and

WHEREAS, the Iowa Department of Transportation was awarded Federal Fiscal Year 2024 Competitive Highway Bridge Program funding and has offered the City of Dyersville a Federal-aid Agreement, identified as Iowa Department of Transportation Agreement No. 6-26-CHBP-025 and Project No. BRM-CHBP-2160(619)--NB-31, for the replacement or rehabilitation of the bridge located on 3rd Avenue SE over the North Fork of the Maquoketa River, identified as FHWA Structure Number 004305; and

WHEREAS, under the Agreement the City of Dyersville will serve as the lead local governmental agency responsible for the project development, construction inspection, and completion of the bridge project, which carries a preliminary estimated total cost of \$1,777,900; and

WHEREAS, under the Agreement the City of Dyersville will be reimbursed from Competitive Highway Bridge Program funds at eighty percent (80%) of eligible construction costs incurred after the effective date of the Agreement, up to a maximum of \$1,422,320, and the City will be responsible for the required twenty percent (20%) match and for all project costs not reimbursed under the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the bridge project will be bundled with two other bridge projects in Jackson County and Dubuque County and let to contract through the Iowa Department of Transportation, and must be let to contract by September 30, 2027, or the Agreement becomes null and void; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement requires that the City's execution be authorized by a formal resolution duly passed and adopted by the City Council, and the City Council finds that entering into the Agreement is in the best interest of the City of Dyersville and its residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DYERSVILLE, IOWA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. APPROVAL OF AGREEMENT. The City Council of the City of Dyersville, Iowa, approves the Iowa Department of Transportation Federal-aid Agreement for a Competitive Highway Bridge Program Project, identified as Iowa Department of Transportation Agreement No. 6-26-CHBP-025 and Project No. BRM-CHBP-2160(619)--NB-31, in substantially the form presented to the Council.

SECTION 2. AUTHORIZATION TO SIGN. The Mayor is authorized to execute the Agreement on behalf of the City of Dyersville, and the City Clerk/Treasurer is directed to attest the Agreement and to certify the Mayor's authority to sign as provided in the Agreement.

SECTION 3. IMPLEMENTATION. The City Administrator is directed to take all actions necessary to carry out the Agreement, including submission of the executed Agreement to the Iowa Department of Transportation and coordination of the bridge project through the Department's letting process.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and adoption.
