

City of Dyersville — Public Notice

Removal of Snow, Ice, and Accumulations from Sidewalks

Effective Date: January 1, 2026

Section 136.15 of the Dyersville Code of Ordinances requires the abutting property owner to promptly remove natural accumulations of snow and ice from sidewalks. To clarify for residents, the City defines “reasonable time” under Section 136.15 as within twenty-four (24) hours after the end of a snow and/or ice event.

If a property owner fails to remove snow or ice within twenty-four (24) hours after a snow and/or ice event, the City Administrator may order removal without prior notice. The City will submit an itemized, verified statement of costs along with a legal description of the property to the City Council. All associated costs will be added as taxes against the property, in accordance with Section 136.15.

This notice takes effect January 1, 2026.

What changes for you:

Clear the full width of your sidewalk within 24 hours after the storm ends. Treat ice. Do not place snow on the city street.
